

# It's time to Register for: 4-H Chicken BBQ, 4-H Turkey BBQ, & Egg Chef Challenges



All Contests will be held on Saturday, July 29th at the Hardin County Extension Office. Pre-registration is required by Friday, July 21st to the LaRue County Extension Office.

the Egg Chef Challenge will be held in the morning — the exact time will depend on the number of participants. The BBQ contests are in the afternoon. 4-Hers must choose between chicken or turkey BBQ. They cannot do both.

For the BBQ contests, the charcoal cannot be lit until the participants are instructed to start. This should be around 1 PM. They will then have 2 hours to finish cooking and hand in their completed product (see rules linked above for details).

For the BBQ contests, the grills, charcoal, lighter fluid, table to work on (half of a 6-8 foot table), aluminum foil for lining the bottom of the grill, and the meat will be provided. The participants are required to provide all other equipment and flavors needed.

For the Egg Chef Challenge, the eggs and the work table are provided. The participants are required to provide the equipment and materials. See the Factsheet for details on how the contest is run. The exact timing of the contest will depend on the number of participants and the preparation time they require prior to their presentation.
