Written Exam highest individual- a tie with Kolton Zimmerman (Fayette County) and Ben Falk (LaRue County)

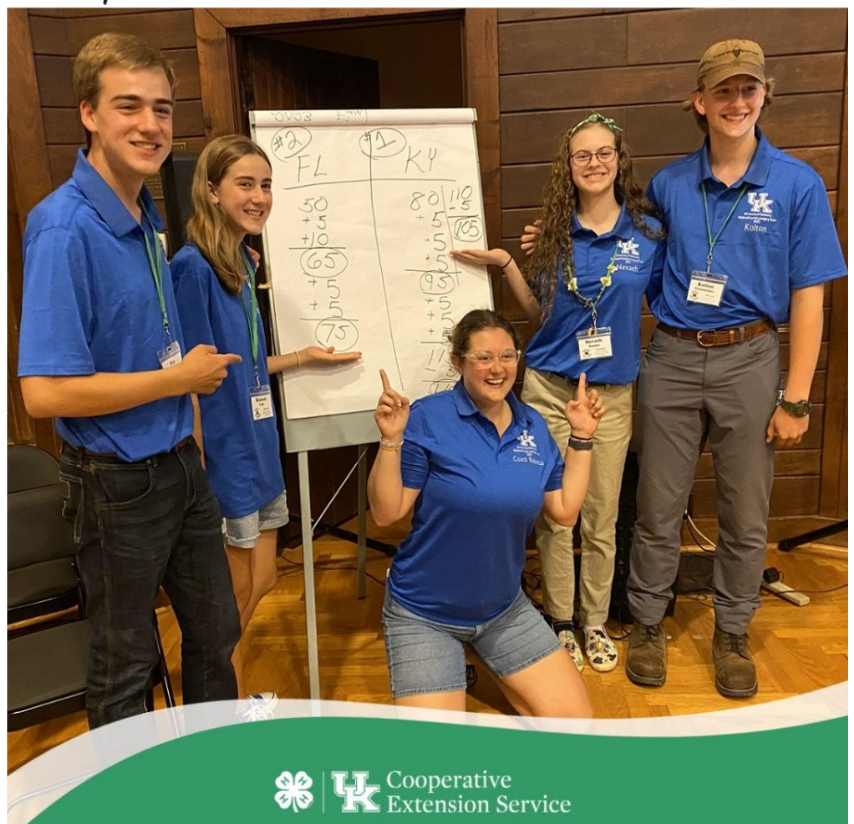
Quiz Bowl Winning Team- KENTUCKY!!! This is the first time in Kentucky history!
